- CS2i is a cross agency service that will provide common e-Business functions required for customers to access spatial and related information in an online environment.
- Operationally CS2i will comprise
 - A Governance Framework
 - An Enabling Framework



An Enabling Framework will offer

- The capacity to access spatial information cost effectively
- Provide access to common tools and services that will provide a seamless means
 of accessing integrated spatial information, based on the business requirements of
 the agencies
- SIX is an integral component of the enabling framework






Governance Framework

 - Policies and Standards








Information & Capability Sharing






Information Sharing




